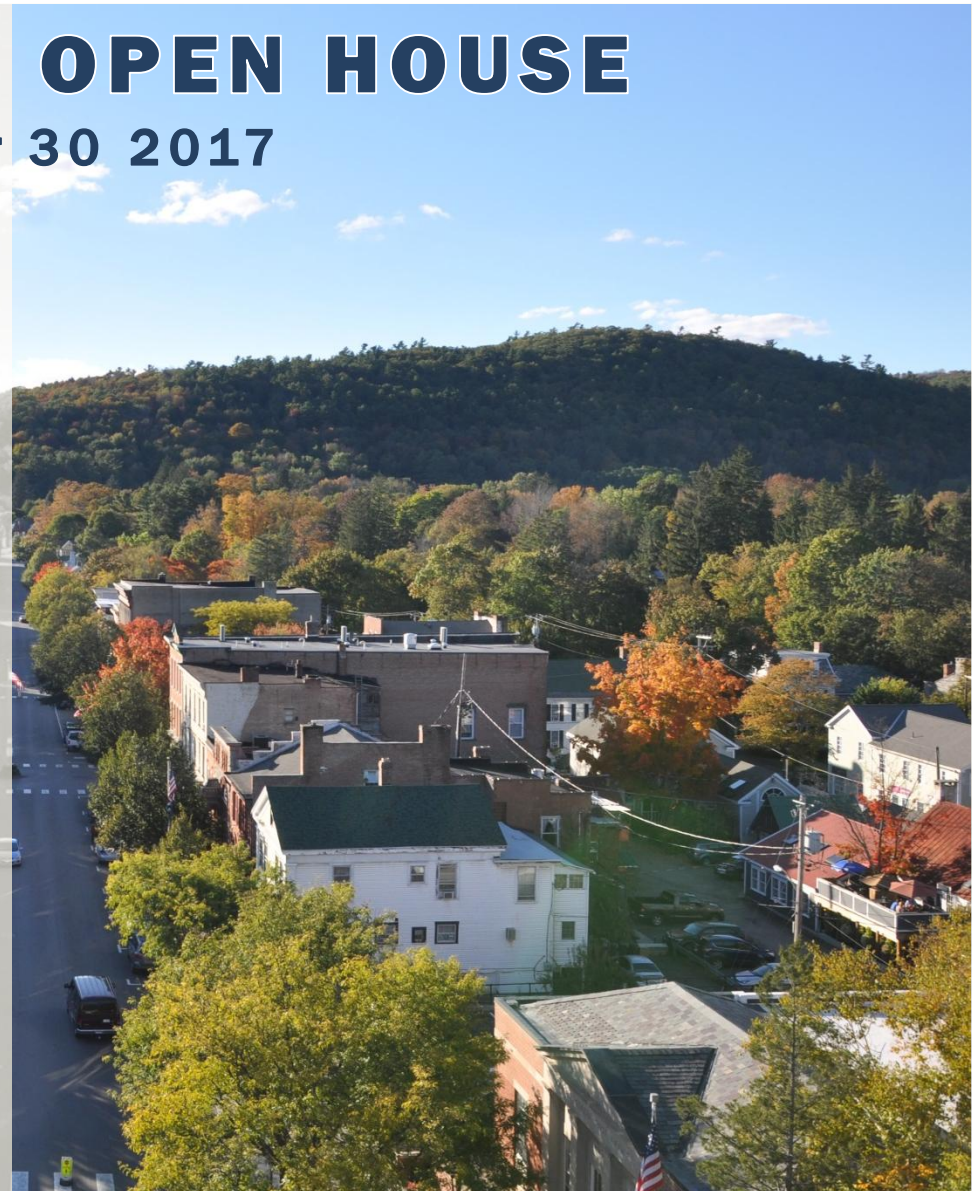

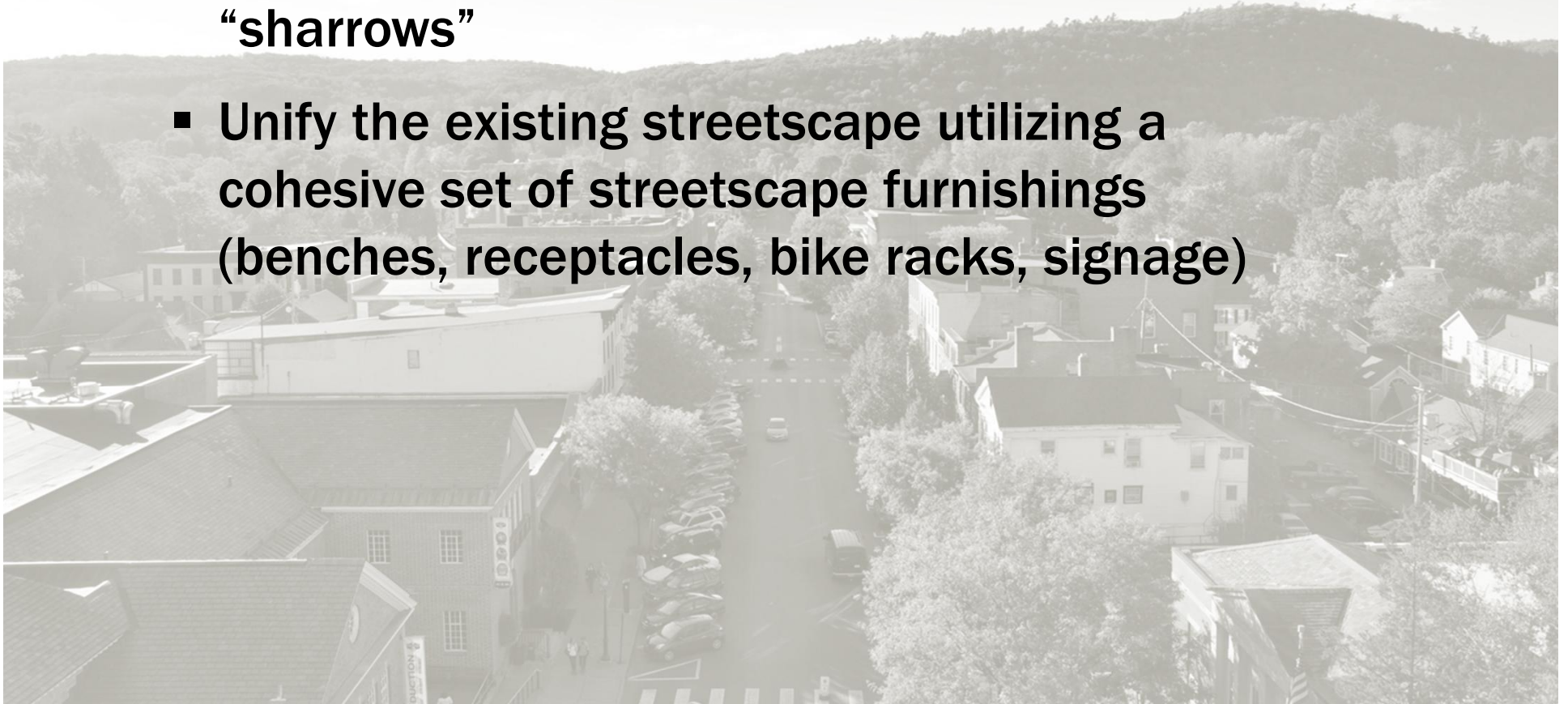

## **PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

- Enhance the overall experience throughout downtown Cooperstown
- Improve the safety, accessibility and functionality of the Main and Chestnut intersection for all users
- Improve pedestrian accessibility and safety
- Continue the aesthetic design concept and materials of GIGP Project recently constructed

## **PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

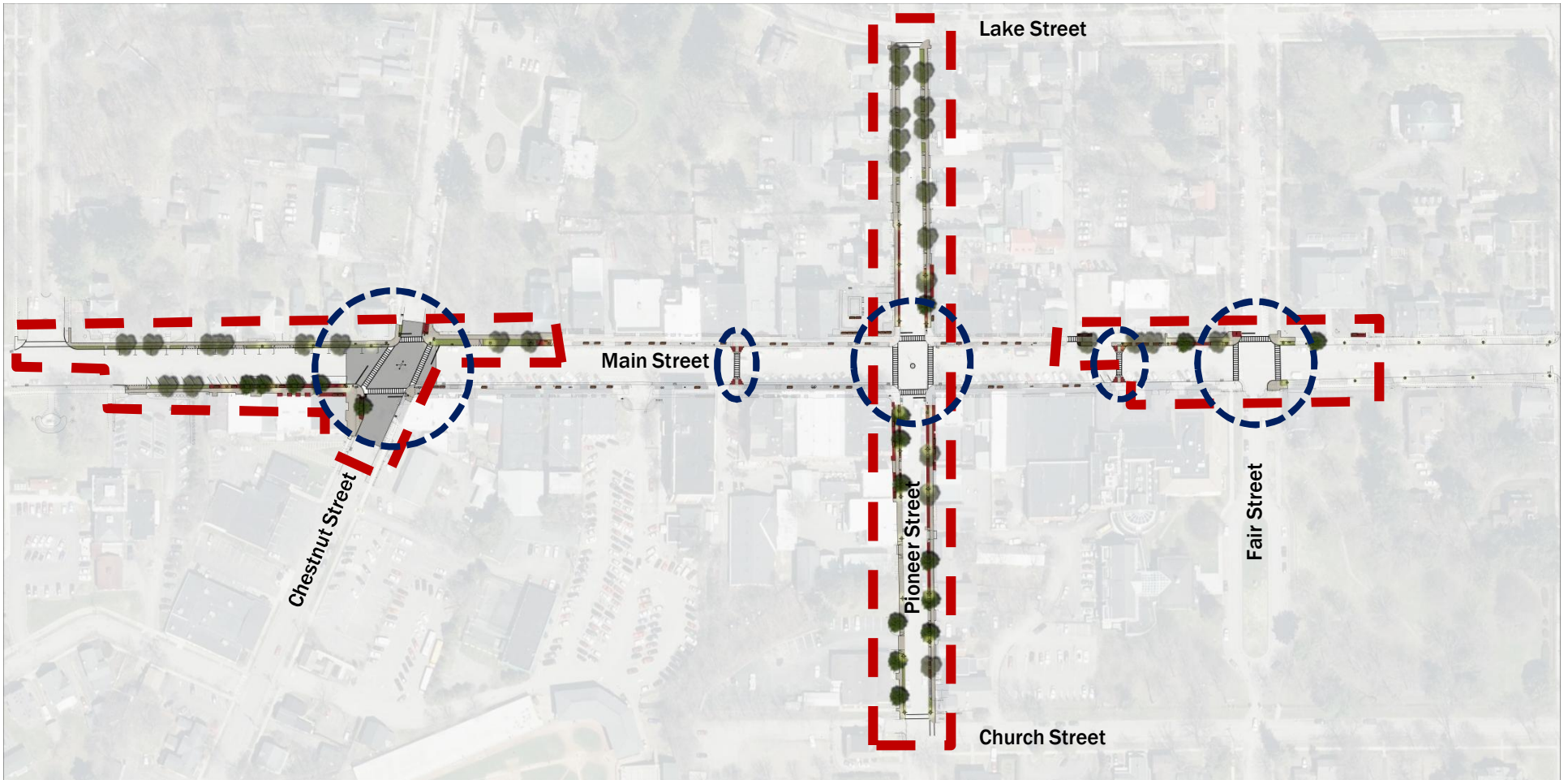
- **Promote the use of bicycles; complement “sharrows”**
- **Unify the existing streetscape utilizing a cohesive set of streetscape furnishings (benches, receptacles, bike racks, signage)**



## **LOCALLY ADMINISTERED FEDERAL AID PROJECT (LAFAP)**

- **Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP)**
  - **\$1.76 Million**
- **Preliminary Design Phase – Design Report**
  - **Evaluated alternatives and options**
  - **Assessed social, cultural, and environmental impacts – no adverse impacts**
  - **Design Approval – October 2017**
  - **Begin Final Design – detailed design & construction documents**

## MAIN & CHESTNUT INTERSECTION

### INTERSECTION OBJECTIVES

- Improve pedestrian safety and accessibility, enhanced crosswalks
- Upgrade traffic signal, add pedestrian signals, aesthetic concerns
- Connect upper Main Street with Downtown, diminish barrier
- Improve functionality for emergency vehicles – pre-emption cycles
- Preserve historic character of intersection

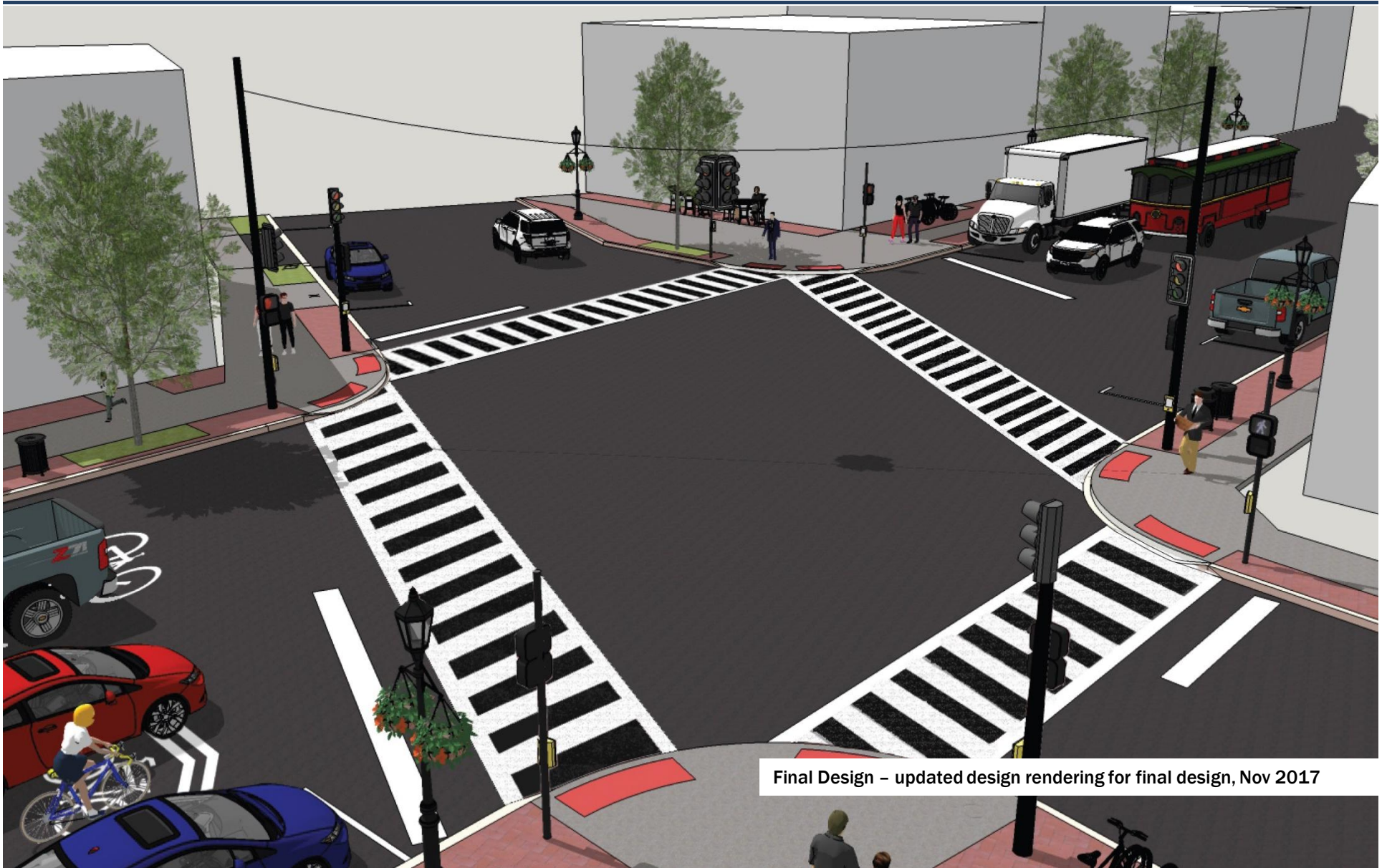


Preliminary Design – selected design option for intersection, June 2015

### TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND SAFETY UPGRADES

- Utilize traffic components to enhance setting & context
- Retain character and aesthetic of existing features

## **INTERSECTION ENHANCEMENTS**

- **Install high visibility, safe and durable pedestrian crossings**
- **Compliant pedestrian ramp design, mid-block treatments**

### NYS EFC GIGP PROJECT

- Stormwater management project, streetscape improvements
- Match aesthetics and continue design palette
- No permeable pavers or stormwater pits in TEP project

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## **STREETSCAPE ELEMENTS**



### **PAVEMENTS AND HARDSCAPE TREATMENTS**

- **Continue palette introduced and installed under GIGP project**
- **No porous pavements or permeable pavers**
- **New concrete sidewalk and clay brick pavers**

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## **STREETSCAPE ELEMENTS**



### **FURNISHINGS**

- Install elements that complement and enhance setting & context
- Unified collection, ease of maintenance and replacements
- Replace along Main Street and Pioneer Street, Pioneer Park

## **STREETSCAPE ELEMENTS**



## **FURNISHINGS**

- **Install elements that complement and enhance setting & context**
- **Unified collection, ease of maintenance and replacements**
- **Continue lighting refurbishment, conversion, and new installations**
- **Matching treatments to street tree plantings**

## **STREETSCAPE ELEMENTS**



## **FURNISHINGS**

- Provide appropriate and required flag uplighting
- Install matching ornamental poles for street banners

# STREETSCAPE ELEMENTS



## SIGNAGE

- New wayfinding and orientation signage, interpretation
- Unified style, flexible wayfinding system

## **SCHEDULE**

- Design Approval Oct 2017
- Final Design Complete Jan 2018
- Project Bidding Mar 2018
- Construction Start Sep 2018
- Construction Complete Nov 2019

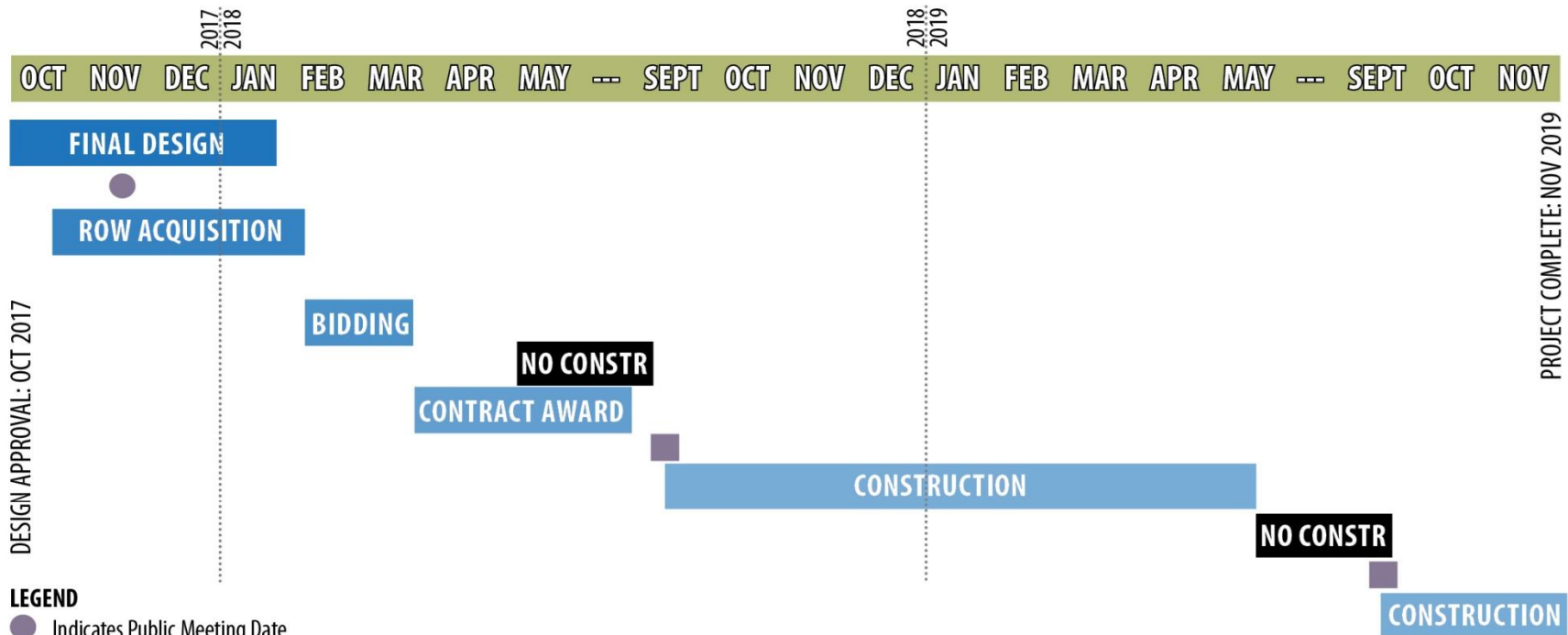
