270-12 A. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in the following locations:
Walnut Street - North
From Chestnut Street to Susquehanna Avenue

Walnut Street - South
Between the Chestnut Street intersection and a point 78 feet east of the east curblineline of Linden Avenue

Walnut Street – South
Between the Susquehanna Avenue intersection and a point 210 feet west of the west curblineline of Susquehanna Avenue.

270-12 (F) The standing or stopping of vehicles between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on weekdays shall be prohibited in the following locations:

Walnut Street – South
From a point 78 feet east of the east curblineline of Linden Avenue to a point 40 feet west of the west curblineline of the entrance to the Cooperstown Elementary School parking lot

Walnut Street – South
From a point 177 feet east of the east curblineline of the service road east of the Cooperstown Elementary School to a point 210 feet west of the east curblineline of Susquehanna Avenue

270-13 (C) The parking or standing of vehicles is prohibited on weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the following locations:

Walnut Street - South

From a point 40 feet west of the west curbline of the entrance to the Cooperstown Elementary School parking lot to a point 177 feet east of the east curbline of the service road east of the Cooperstown Elementary School to Susquehanna Avenue
